The UMKC School of Medicine Summer Scholars Program began in 1980 to identify minority and disadvantaged high school juniors and seniors in the Kansas City metropolitan area who have the scholastic ability and interest to pursue a career in the health sciences.

The Summer Scholars program is for minority and disadvantaged juniors and seniors attending public and private high schools in the Kansas City metropolitan area (Johnson and Wyandotte Counties in Kansas, and Jackson, Platte, Clay and Cass Counties in Missouri.) However, all interested students are encouraged to apply.

An Advanced Summer Scholars program runs concurrently with the regular Summer Scholars program. It is open to students who completed the regular program the previous summer. The advanced program focuses on clinical observation and includes a unit on Health Sciences Research in which students are paired with medical school faculty members.

The Summer Scholars programs are held during the month of July, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
